

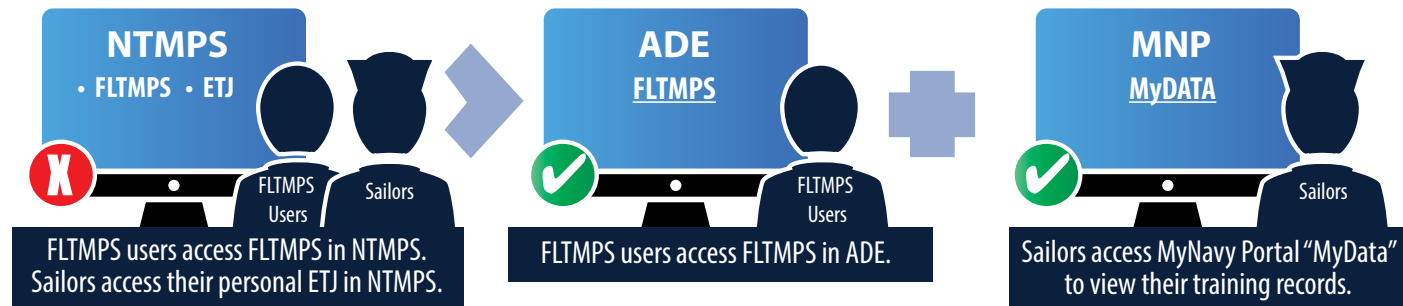

NTMPS Core Applications Migrate to ADE

1. OVERVIEW OF THE CHANGE

The Navy Training Management Planning System (NTMPS), an integrated suite of manpower, personnel, and training applications, is migrating to a government cloud environment in the Authoritative Data Environment (ADE). This transition involves modernizing the system's code and moving current NTMPS applications to new platforms. Current capabilities remain the same, but access to those capabilities will change. NTMPS will sunset in September 2026.



2. PURPOSE & BENEFITS

This modernization is a required technology migration to ensure the Navy's training and personnel systems remain secure, reliable, and compliant. While the underlying technology is changing, the process is designed to be transparent to users.

- **Continuity of Service:** The NTMPS core applications—Fleet Training Management Planning System (FLTMS), Electronic Training Jacket (ETJ), and Online Applications Reporting System (OARS)—will look and function the same as before.
- **Improved Reporting:** Leverages an industry-leading tool to enable enhanced data and analytics capabilities.
- **Modernized Platform:** The move to the government cloud (ADE) enhances software maintenance, integration, and cybersecurity.

3. KEY IMPACTS & REQUIRED ACTIONS

FLTMS Users (~80K)	The Fleet Training Management & Planning System (FLTMS) will be accessible in ADE.	Use the new link for FLTMS access. (https://fltms.appsprod.adc3n.navy.mil/) The old link will have a 30-day automatic redirect. For help email FLTMS_SUPPORT@us.navy.mil
NATO FLTMS Users (~60) and others currently accessing FLTMS through a commercial Internet connection	Direct access to FLTMS will no longer be available through the current link.	You must establish a Department of Defense Information Network (DODIN) connection to continue using FLTMS in ADE. NOTE: Using Nautilus Virtual Desktop (NVD) is one way to access a DODIN connection.

4. TRANSITION TIMELINE

- July 24, 2026: ETJ data migration to MyData completed. (Legacy ETJ still available until August 4, 2026.)
- August 4, 2026: NTMPS cutover to ADE. New link becomes active.
