

### MYNAVY FAMILY MOBILE APPLICATION 3.0

1. MyNavy Family (MNF) Mobile Application 3.0 is an official U.S. Navy application (hereinafter “the application”) that is provided as a public service to Service members and their families by the Navy Culture and Force Resilience Office (OPNAV N17).
2. Any communications using, or data stored on, this United States Government (USG) Information System 9IS) are not private; are subject to routine monitoring, interception, and search; and may be disclosed or used for any USG authorized purpose.
3. Information presented on this service not identified as protected by copyright is considered public information and may be distributed or copied. Use of appropriate byline, photo, and image credits are requested.
4. This application may access the camera or photo library to facilitate the functionality of the mobile application. End user agreement is required before the application may access the camera or photo library.
5. For application management, information is collected for statistical purposes. The application uses software programs to create summary statistics, which are used for such purposes as assessing what information is of most and least interest, determining technical design specifications, and identifying application performance or problem areas.
6. Except for authorized law enforcement investigations and to maintain required correspondence files, no other attempts are made to identify individual users or their usage habits.
7. Unauthorized attempts to upload information or change information on this application are strictly prohibited and may be punishable under the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act of 1987 and the National Information Infrastructure Protection Act (18 U.S.C. § 1030).
8. Personally Identifiable Information (PII) is any information about an individual that can be used to distinguish or trace an individual and that is linked or linkable to specified individual, alone or when combined with other personal or identifying information (reference: DoD Directive 5400.11, “DoD Privacy Program,” October 29, 2014). We do not obtain PII about you when you use our application(s) unless you choose to provide such information to us.

The application will obtain end user personal information from, and send end user personal information to, other Navy and Department of Defense (DoD) systems in response to end user actions on the application. For example, when an end user submits a feedback form through the application, the feedback and the personal information provided by the end user (ie. Full Name and email address) will be sent to the MyNavy Family Product Owner at the Sailor and Family Readiness Program Policy Office (OPNAV N171B).
